1. In relation to: **HAZARD IDENTIFICATION AND RISK ASSESSMENT DIESEL FUMES**

at 158 MORRISON MIDLAND 6056 on 09 Jul 2010

I have formed the opinion that you are contravening regulation 3.1 of the Occupational Safety and Health Regulations 1996 and the grounds for my opinion are: My investigation revealed that you are the employer at this workplace. Scientific monitoring indicated that hazardous substances in diesel fumes, including Nitrous Oxide, Nitrogen Dioxide and Carbon Monoxide are present in the atmosphere when appliances are running in the engine room. Appliances are run twice daily for operational checks and during turn outs. Review of information provided by FESA indicated that as far as practicable you have not identified each hazard to which a person at the workplace is likely to be exposed; assessed the risk of injury or harm to a person resulting from each hazard, if any; and considered the means by which the risk may be reduced.

You are required to remedy the above by no later than 03 Sep 2010 at 1700 hours.

2. You are directed to take the following measures: As far as is practicable,

- Identify each hazard to which a person at the workplace is likely to be exposed, in particular in relation to diesel fumes.
- Assess the risk of injury or harm to a person resulting from each hazard, if any.
- Consider the means by which the risk may be reduced.
